All about Me

Ongoing ideas to do at home:

Encourage your child to be independent and make their own choices.	"Can you carry your bag today?" "What shoes are you going to wear today?" Introducing sitting on the toilet between nappy changes
Developing strength in your child's fingers. This will help to develop their fine motor skills	Making lines, circles and swirls in a tray of flour/salt with your fingers. Make your own gloop (cornflour and a little water)
Giving your child time to talk. Try to cut down on time having their dummy	Sing nursery rhymes, share bedtime stories and chat about what you are doing during the day. If your child is trying to talk, remove their dummy
Discuss feelings	Begin to talk about feeling happy, sad, angry. "I can see you're feeling a bit angry right now"

Things to try at home:

- Have a look in the mirror, talk about the differences you see. Do you have the same colour hair? Are you wearing glasses or not?
- Can you use some items around the house to make a face?
- Have a walk to the park/woods. Can you collect all things autumn (leaves, twigs, conkers) to bring in to REY for our activities. You will be given a brown bag to collect your items.
- Can you sort these items into different colours? How many are brown? Are they all the **same** shape?
